Notice: Purchasing bus tickets

Tickets for intercity and express buses, including airport limousine buses, can be purchased on various websites and mobile apps. This guidebook does not provide a separate list as not all sites and apps offer English services, and some may not accept international credit cards (Amex, BC, Visa, Mastercard).

Transportation Systems in Gyeongju

City Buses and Taxis

Visitors can get around Gyeongju on city buses or taxis. (There is no subway.) Standard bus fares for adults are KRW 1,700 on *'seated' buses and KRW 1,300 on regular buses. Transportation card users receive a discount of KRW 50 and free transfers between buses. Taxi fares start at KRW 2,800 and charge metered rates. (There are no 'mobeum' or deluxe taxis.) *'Seated' buses have more comfortable seats and make fewer stops than regular buses to offer faster services.

Transfers

Tap your transportation card on the card reader as you board the bus. The reader will beep and display the bus fare (top) and the remaining balance (bottom). Remember to tap your card on the reader by the rear door before getting off the bus to take advantage of free transfers and discounted fares.

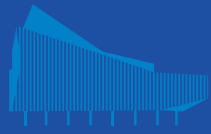
Purchasing Transportation Cards

Tmoney and Cashbee are transportation cards accepted across Korea. They can be purchased for KRW 2,500 throughout the city in convenience stores like GS25, CU, and 7-Eleven and charged in KRW 1,000 units.

Visitors arriving at Singyeongju Station (KTX) can purchase their transportation cards from a convenience store called StoryWay on the 1st floor. Visitors arriving at Gyeongju Express Bus Terminal or Gyeongju Intercity Bus Terminal can purchase their cards from nearby stores.

HICO Location



HICO is located within Bomun Lake Resort (Bomun Tourist Complex). It is 21 km from Singyeongju Station which is served by KTX, 11 km from Gyeongju Intercity and Express Bus Terminals where the airport limousine bus stops, and 90 km from Gimhae International Airport.

Gyeongju is divided into seven districts: Bomun Lake Resort, Bulguksa Temple, Downtown, Namsan (Southern Mountain), East Bay, Seoak (Western Mountain), and Northern. Of these, Bomun Lake Resort is an all-inclusive tourist district centered around Bomun Lake. It includes hotels, condominiums, golf courses, theme parks, theaters and other entertainment facilities as well as HICO, the area's main venue.

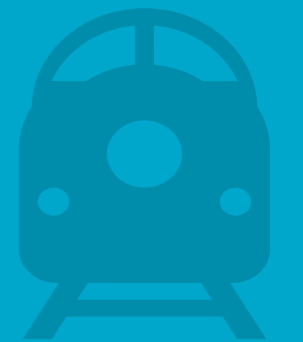

Getting to Gyeongju





(1) Flights

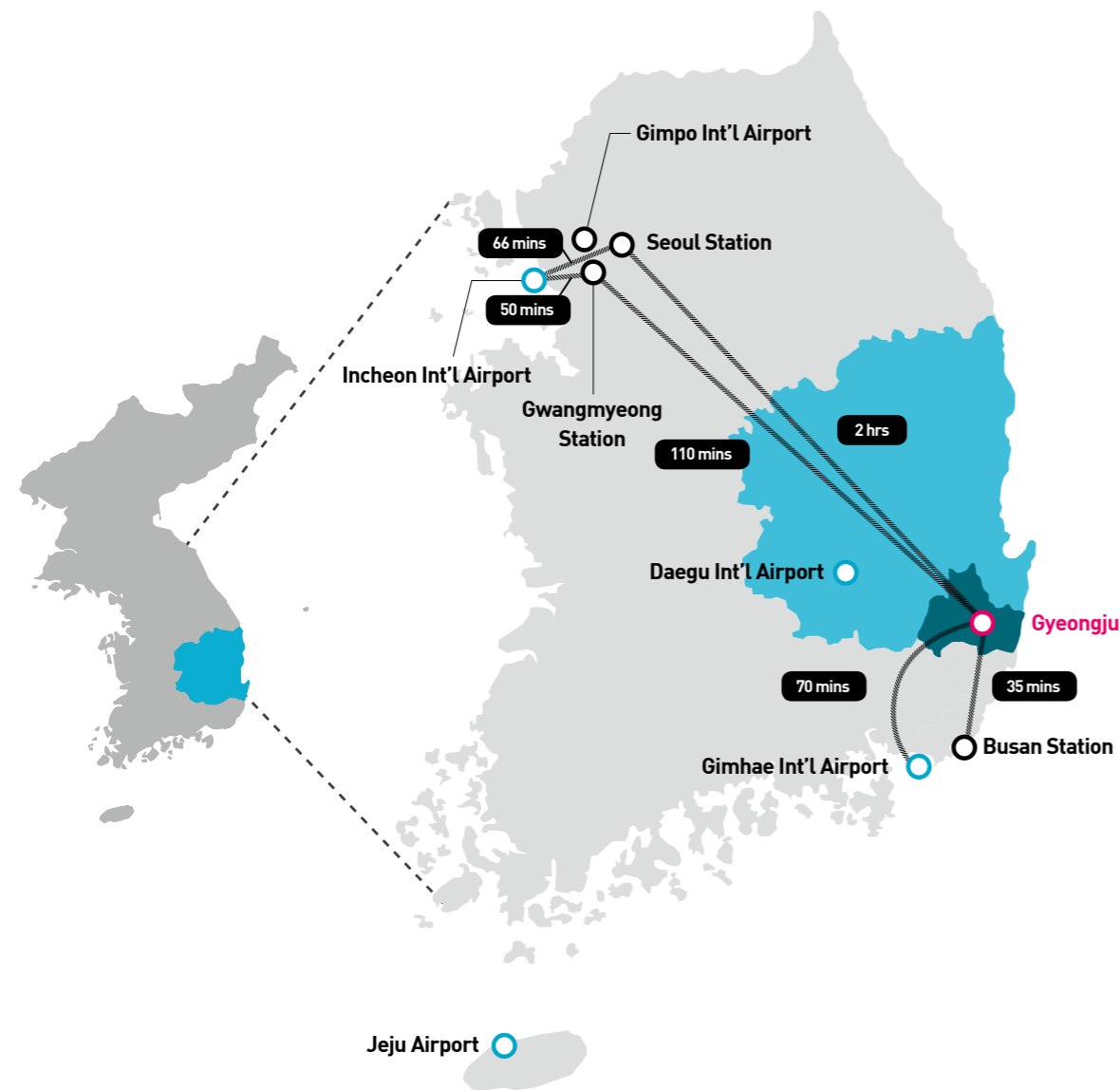
Situated in southeastern Korea, Gyeongju is accessible by two major international airports.

Gimhae International Airport is connected to 39 cities in 12 countries throughout Asia, including Beijing and Tokyo, with over 1,000 flights a week. From the airport, Gyeongju is just 70 minutes away by an airport shuttle service which operates 20 times a day.

Incheon International Airport is connected to 185 cities in 50 countries with more than 2,000 flights a week. There is an airport limousine bus to Gyeongju which takes about 5 hours and runs 8 times a day.

Visitors can also take a train to Gyeongju from Seoul Station. Options for getting to Seoul Station from the airport include taking the airport limousine bus (90 minutes, 80+ times a day) or the airport express train AREX (Direct Route: 51 minutes, 26 times a day at 40~60 minute intervals; Regular Route: 66 minutes, 98 times a day at 6~8 minute intervals).

Trains to Gyeongju also leave from Gwangmyeong Station. The airport limousine bus from Incheon Int'l Airport to Gwangmyeong Station takes 50 minutes and runs 50+ times a day at 20~30 minute intervals. From Gwangmyeong Station, the KTX train to Gyeongju takes 1 hour 50 minutes and runs 15~17 times a day.



1) Gimhae Int'l Airport (Busan): recommended for visitors from Asia

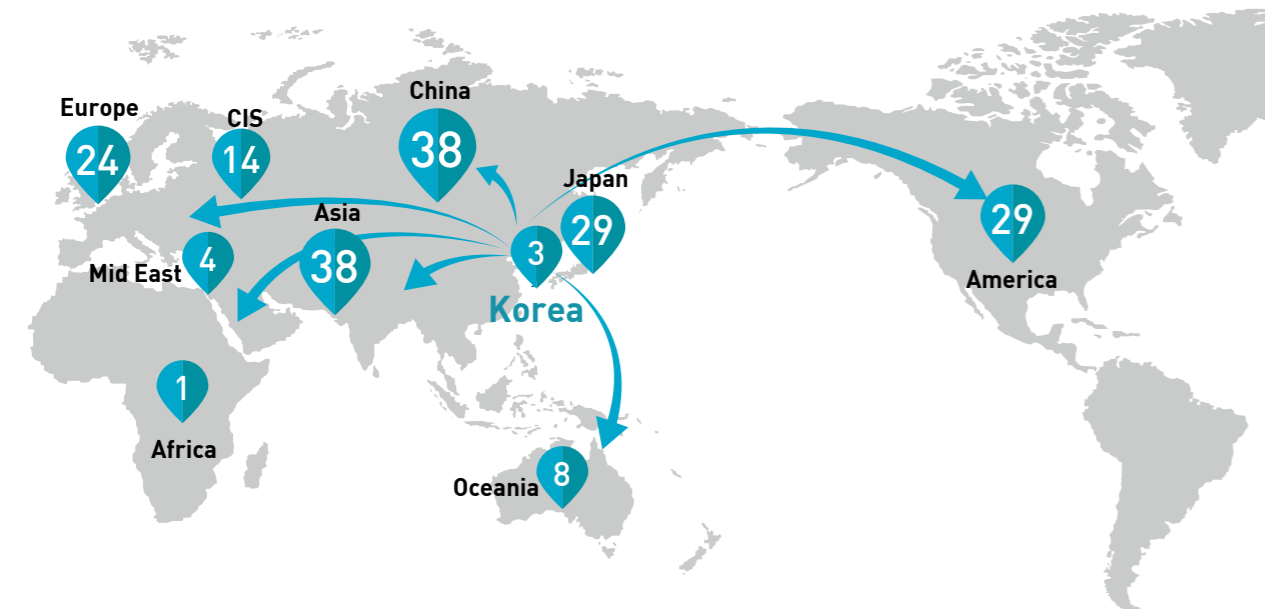


Useful tip

Visitors from Europe and the Americas can fly to Gimhae Int'l Airport with a layover in China (Beijing, Shanghai, Hong Kong) or Japan (Tokyo, Osaka, etc.). Hotels near Gimhae Int'l Airport have limited availability, so visitors are recommended to reserve rooms early or to consider hotels in their layover city.

2) Incheon International Airport (Seoul)

- Domestic routes: Gimhae (Gimhae Int'l Airport), Daegu (Daegu Int'l Airport), Jeju Island (Jeju Int'l Airport)
- International routes: 84 airlines, 50 countries, 185 cities



Notice

Incheon Int'l Airport has two terminals. Terminal 1 serves both foreign and domestic airlines, including Asiana Airlines, Jeju Air, Jin Air, T'way, Eastar Jet, and Air Seoul. Terminal 2, newly opened in January 2018, serves Korean Air, Delta Air Lines, Air France, and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines. Travel time between the two terminals is about 20 minutes, and there is a free shuttle train service that leaves every 5 minutes. It takes at least 5 hours to reach Gyeongju from Incheon Int'l Airport. For travelers who had a long flight or late arrival, we recommend staying the night in a hotel near Incheon Int'l Airport before leaving for Gyeongju.

(2) Trains

1) Singyeongju Station_KTX

Visitors using the high-speed KTX train service from Seoul and other major cities will arrive at Singyeongju Station.

2) Gyeongju Station_Mugunghwa

Gyeongju Station is a stop on the Mugunghwa Line which runs from Seoul (Cheongnyangni Station) to Busan (Bujeon Station).

Notice

In addition to Singyeongju and Gyeongju Stations, the city is also served by Seogyongju Station. However, Seogyongju Station is inconveniently located from HICO and we advise against using it. Visitors using the Mugunghwa Line should make sure they get off at Gyeongju Station, not Seogyongju Station.

(3) Intercity & Express Buses

1) Gyeongju Intercity Bus Terminal

Visitors taking the airport limousine bus from Incheon Int'l Airport toward Gyeongju will arrive at the Intercity Bus Terminal.

- **Service route (cities): Incheon Int'l Airport, Seoul (Dong-Seoul), Daegu (Dong-, Seo-, Buk- Daegu), Busan, etc.**

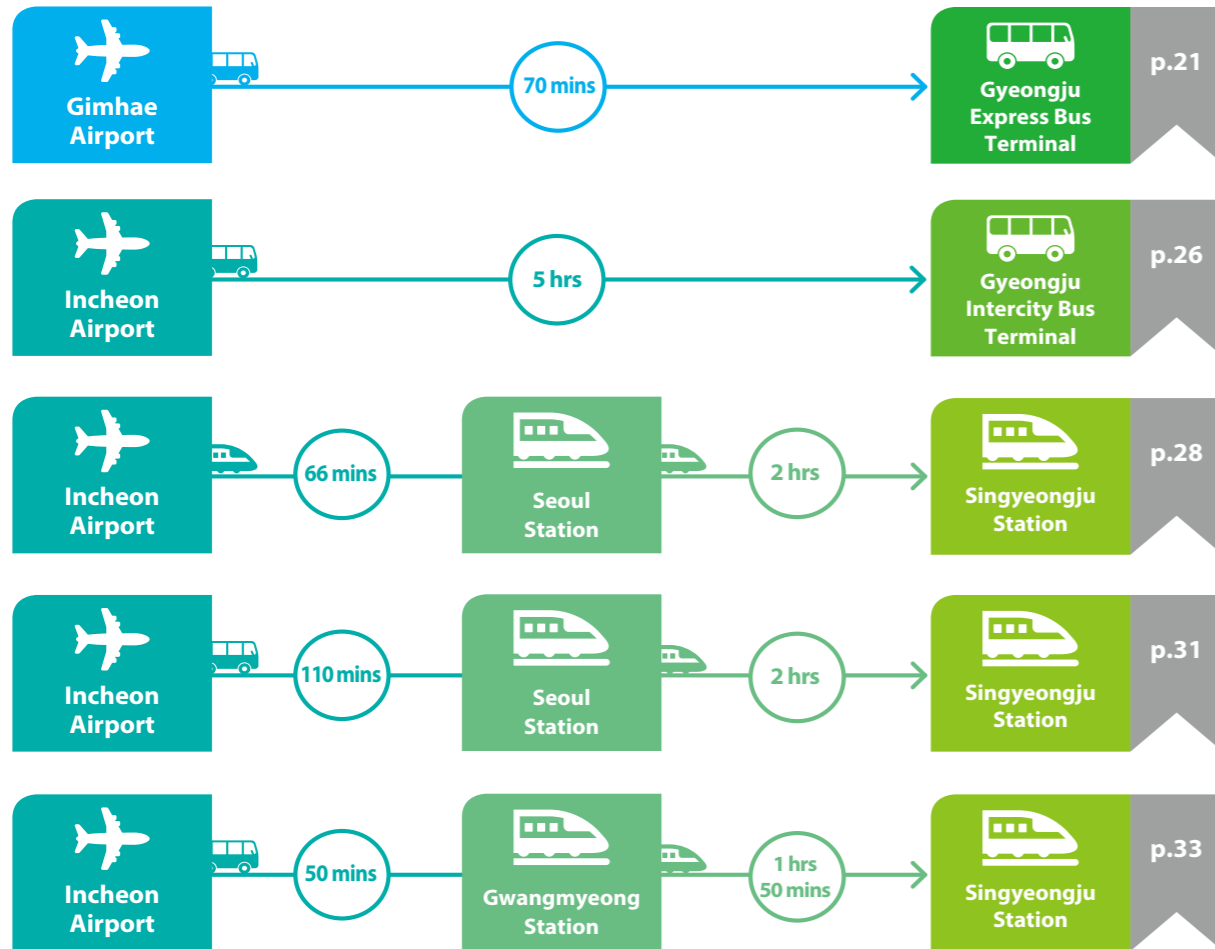

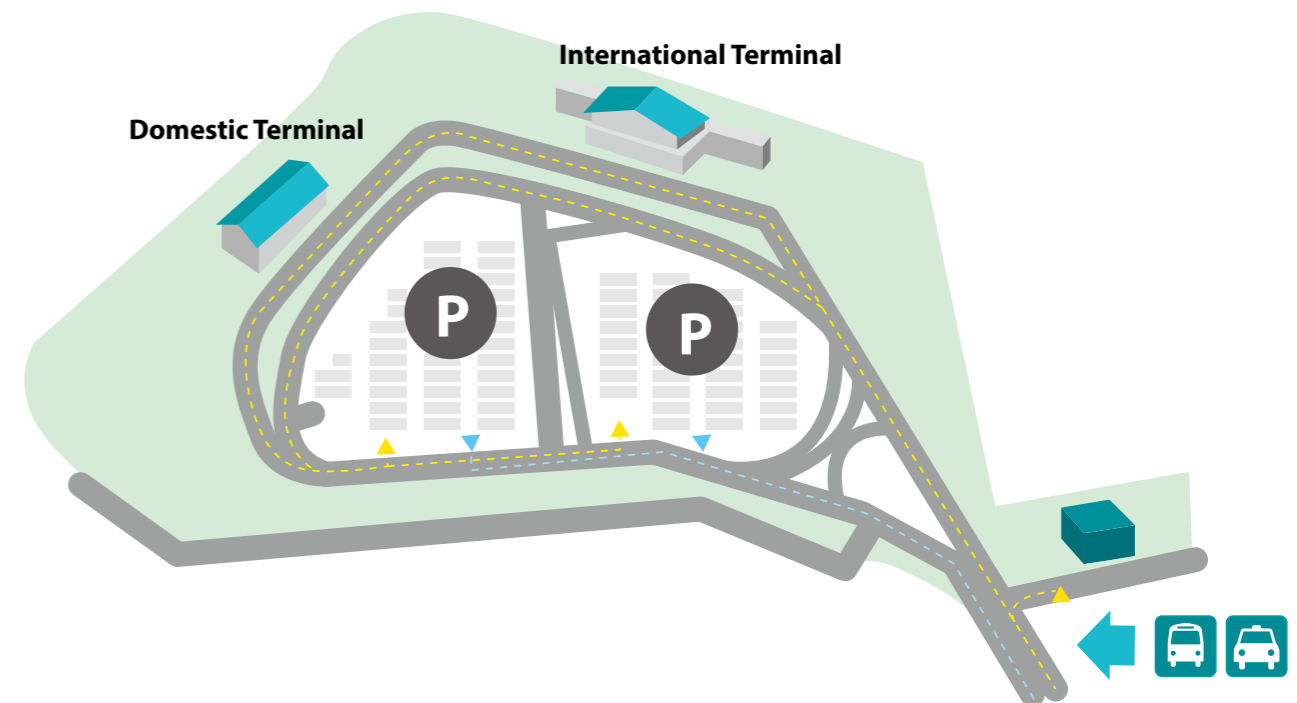
» 5 ways to get to Gyeongju



(1) Entering Korea via Gimhae International Airport: for Visitors from Asia



The airport limousine bus from Gimhae Int'l Airport to Gyeongju runs 20 times a day and takes approx. 70 minutes. The bus leaves from the airport's International Terminal and stops by the Domestic Terminal before proceeding to Gyeongju. Travel time between the two terminals is approx. 5 minutes.

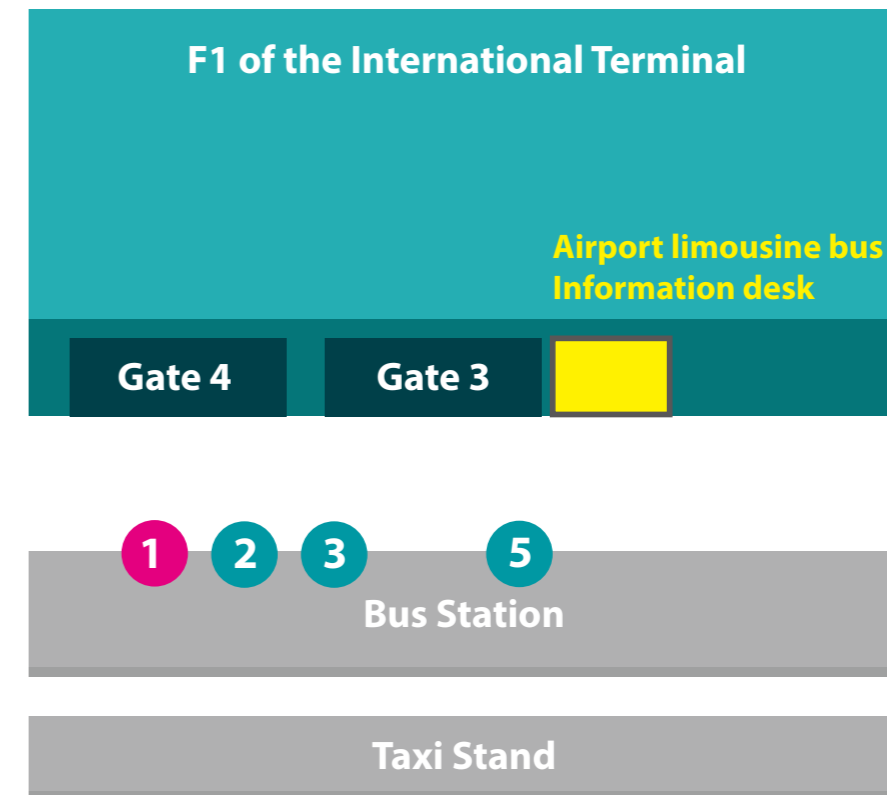

② Tickets for the airport limousine bus: purchasing and boarding locations

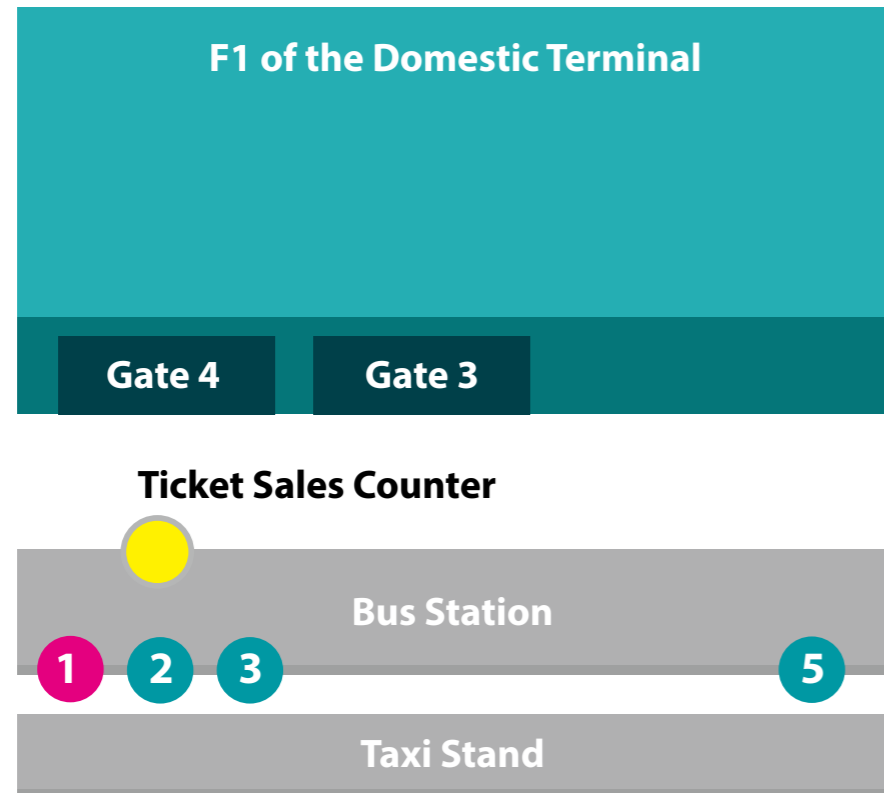
» Boarding from the International Terminal

Visitors who arrive at the International Terminal can purchase tickets from the 'airport limousine bus information desk' on F1 next to Gate 3. The bus will depart from Platform 1-1, outside Gate 4 on F1.



» **Boarding from the Domestic Terminal**

Visitors who arrive at the Domestic Terminal can purchase tickets from the ticket sales counter in front of Platform 2. The bus departs from Platform 1 outside Gate 4 on F1.

Airport Limousine Bus: Gyeongju Express Bus Terminal → Gimhae Int'l Airport

- The airport limousine bus from Gyeongju to Gimhae Int'l Airport runs 20 times a day and takes about 70 minutes. Gyeongju is a popular destination for international conferences from March until November. Tickets for the airport limousine bus to Gimhae Int'l Airport sell out quickly. We recommend purchasing tickets from the ticket booth at Gyeongju Express Bus Terminal ahead of time (cash and credit cards accepted).

(2) Entering Korea via Incheon International Airport

1) Incheon International Airport -> Gyeongju



An airport limousine bus ride from Incheon Airport to Gyeongju Intercity Bus Terminal will take about 5 hours. The bus leaves 8 times a day from Terminal 2, then stops by Terminal 1 which is about 20 minutes away. Of the 8 daily buses, 2 also stop by the Songdo New Town Intercity Bus Transfer Center. Be sure to get off at Gyeongju as it is not the last stop on the line, and the bus will proceed to the next city, Pohang.

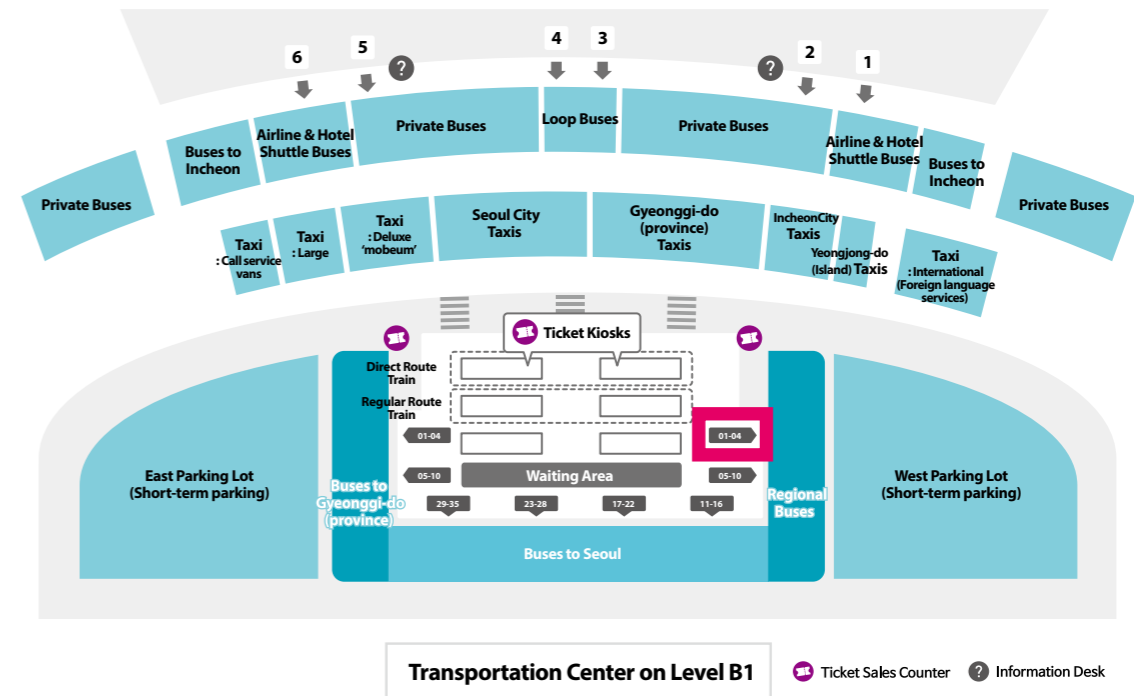

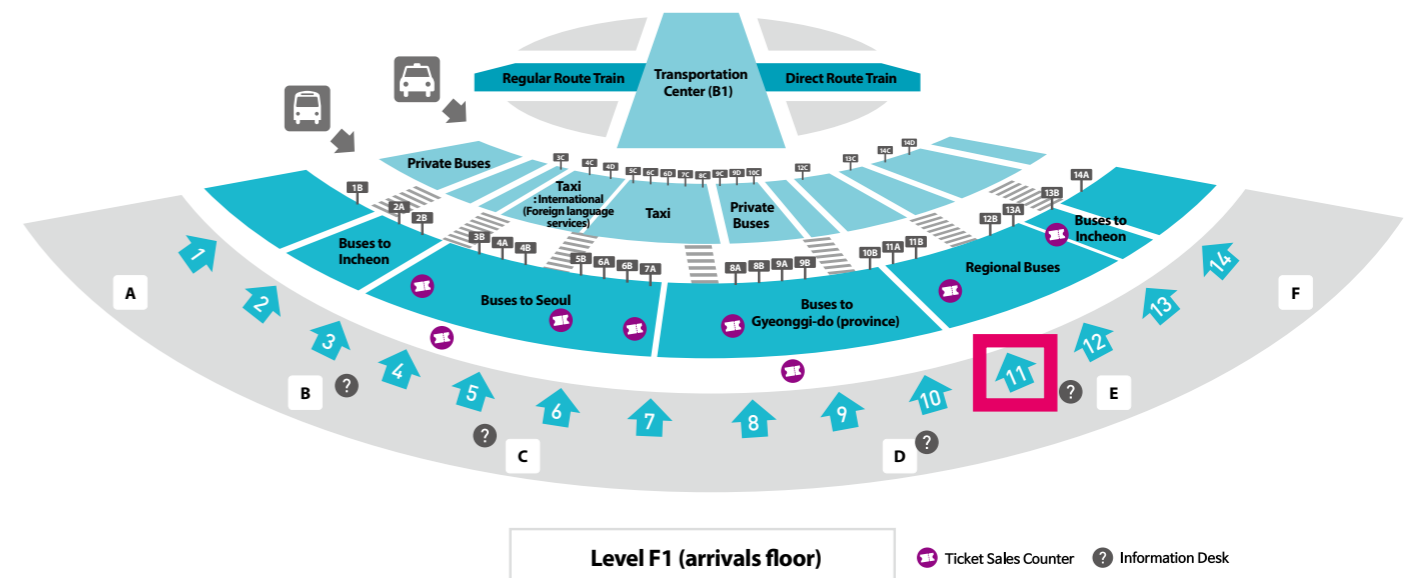

 > Tickets can be purchased inside Terminal 1 next to Gates 4 and 9 on Level F1 or outside at the bust ticket kiosks near Gates 4, 6, 7, 8, 11, 13 or Platform 9C. Additional information about the bus service is also available at these locations.





2) Incheon Int'l Airport → Seoul Station → Gyeongju

- Visitors who prefer not to take the airport limousine bus from Incheon Int'l Airport can reach Gyeongju via Seoul Station.



• Incheon Int'l Airport (AREX) → Seoul Station

AREX, the airport express train, runs direct and regular routes between Incheon Int'l Airport and Seoul Station. The direct route runs straight from the airport to Seoul Station while the regular route makes ten stops along the way.

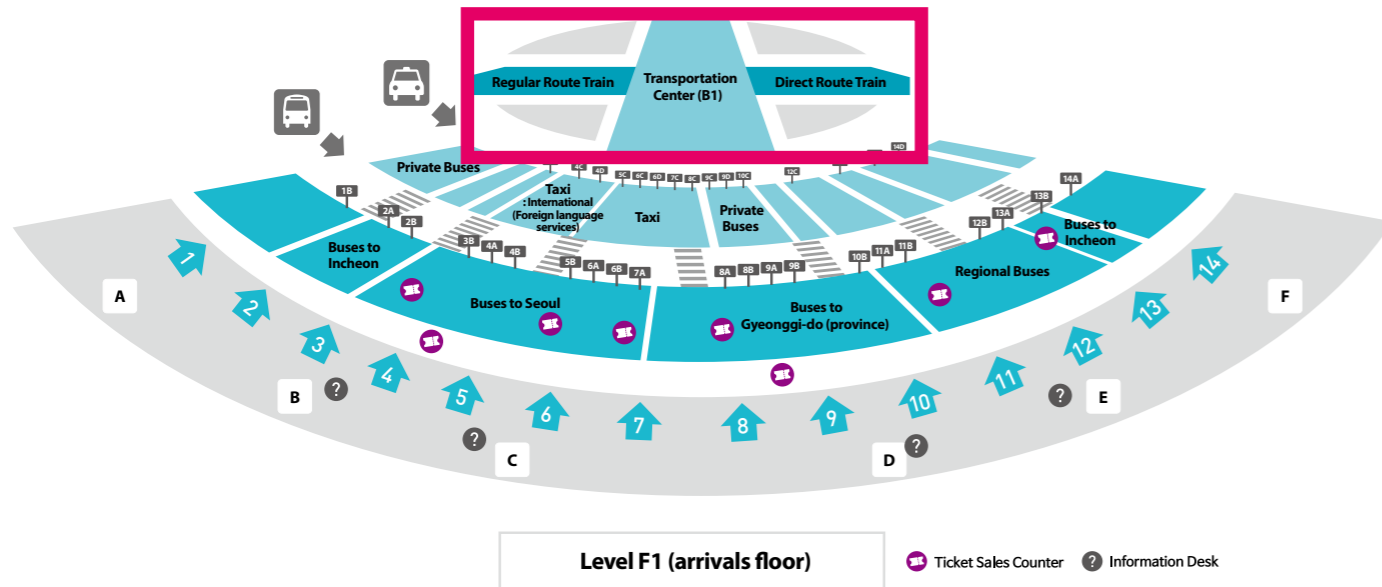

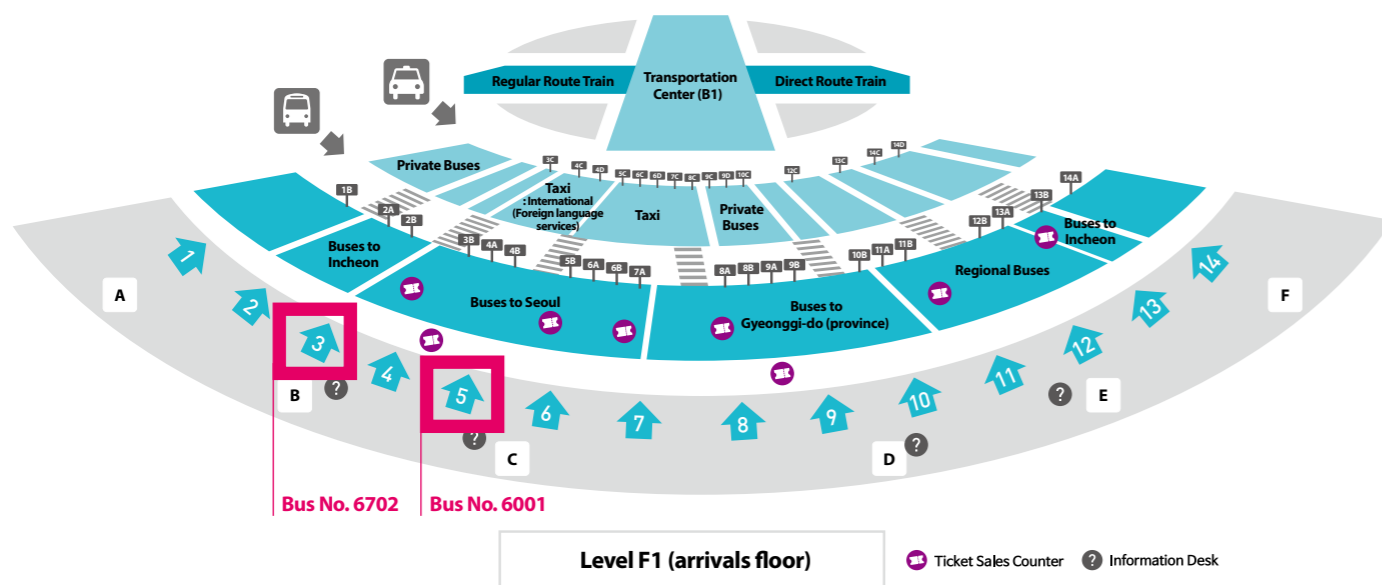

1) Airport Limousine Bus: Gyeongju → Incheon Int'l Airport

- The airport limousine bus from Gyeongju to Incheon Int'l Airport runs 8 times a day and takes about 4:30 to 5 hours. To avoid any inconvenience or delays, we recommend buying tickets ahead of time at Gyeongju Intercity Bus Terminal.

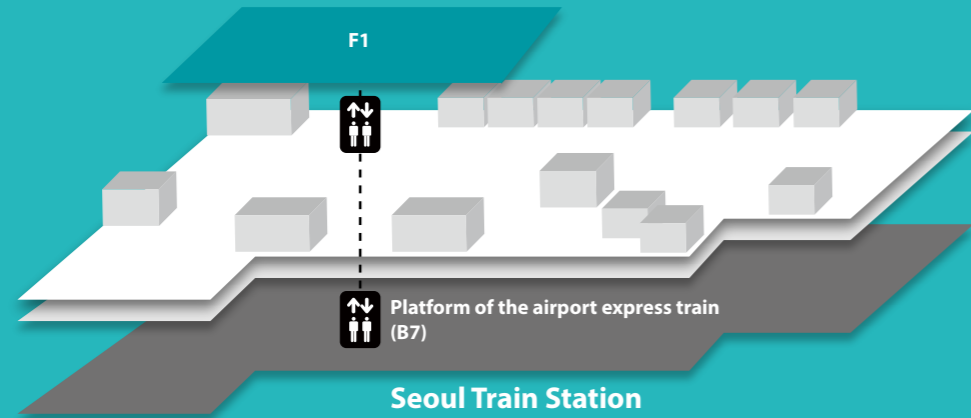

Getting to HICO



(1) Singyeongju Station → HICO



The city bus stop and taxi stand are located 10 meters to the right of Gate 1 outside F1 of the station. Bus No. 700 takes a direct route to HICO (approx. 21 km and 40 minutes), and the fare is KRW 1,700. A taxi ride to HICO will take 30 minutes and cost about KRW 29,000 one-way. Please note that there are no currency exchange facilities at Singyeongju Station. Please exchange your cash for Korean won at Incheon Airport. (We also recommend that you include KRW 1,000 bills which are the smallest available denomination.)

There is also a Tourist Information Center next to Gate 1 on F1 of the station where visitors can ask for directions or more information.

Taxis in Gyeongju

Most taxis in the Gyeongju area accept credit cards.
 However, some may request cash only, and it's always useful to carry some cash (in KRW).
 The basic fare begins at KRW 2,800.
 Please note, rates may vary depending on the district or time of day.

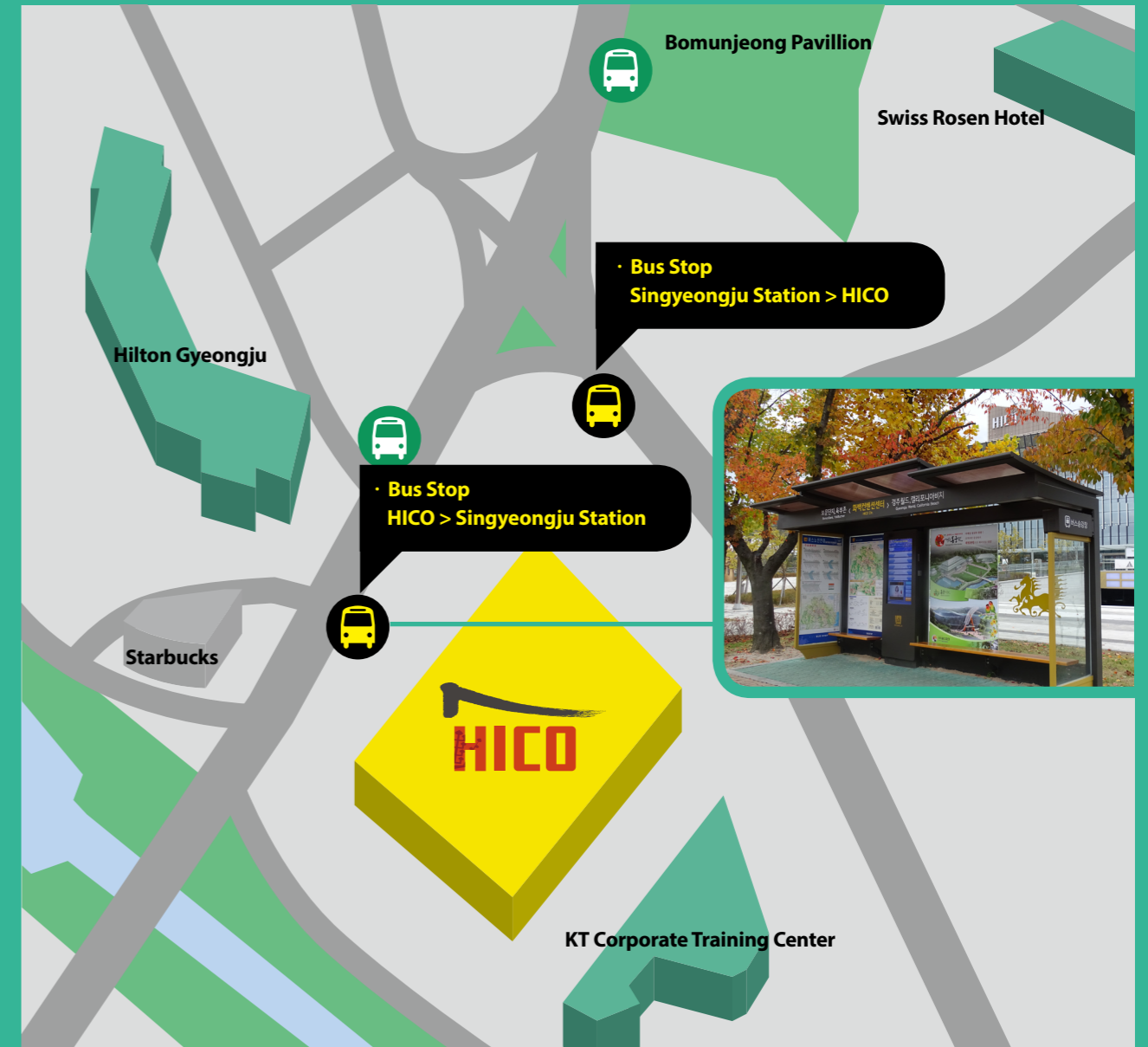

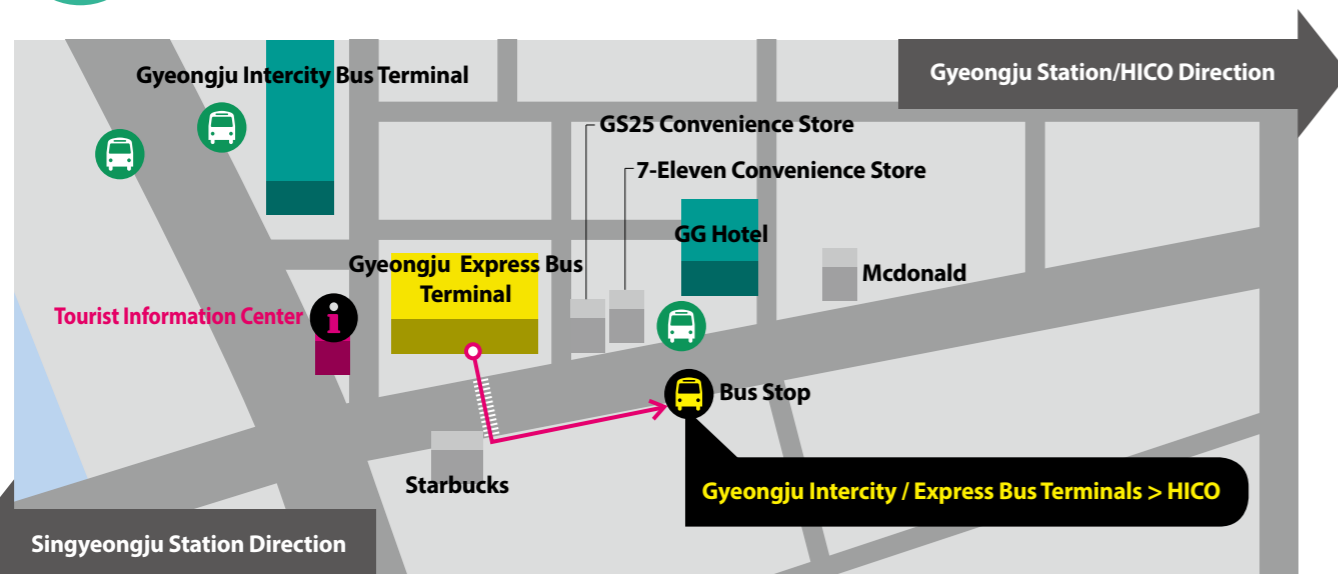
